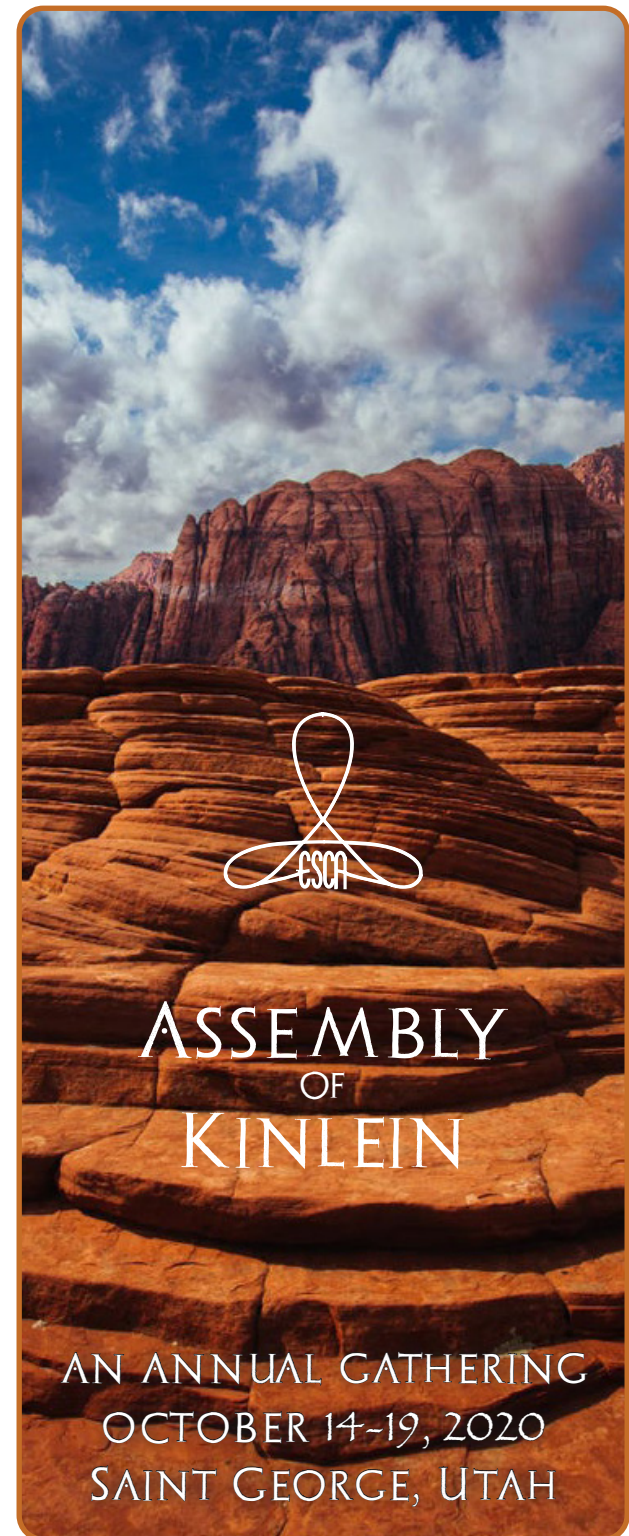

ABOUT KINLEIN ASSEMBLY

The American Kinlein Association (AKA) plans and convenes the Assembly of Kinlein, a coming together of kinleiners. During the Assembly kinleiners exercise responsibility for all aspects of the AKA and participate in continuing learning through seminar.

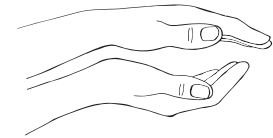

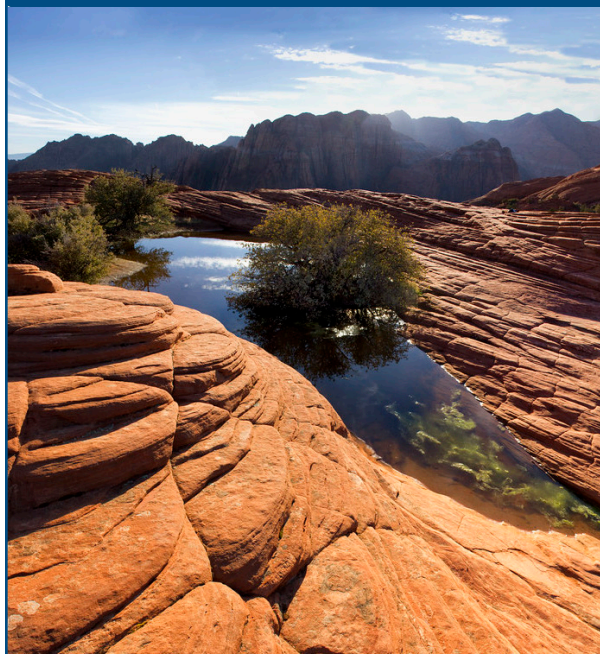
